Tent Anchoring

**Frame tents must be anchored to hold them down. Pole tents must be anchored to shape them and hold them up!
Come learn the tools, tips, and techniques for achieving safe tent installations and what not to do.**

Join the Tent Rental Division (TRD) of the Advanced Textiles Association (ATA), for an in-person tent anchoring class. Proper anchoring of tents is critical to the safety of the occupants. This class is for fire code officials who are responsible for the plan review, permit, and inspection of tent installations. How much weight is enough weight? Are water barrels still permitted? These and other questions will be discussed during this classroom and in-person demonstration of tent ballasting/anchoring methods. Water barrels are no longer the accepted practice for tent anchoring.

Presenters are TRD Board Members Kevin Vasquez, owner of Made in the Shade Tent Rentals, out of Sacramento, and Nick Deninno founder and former owner of PTG Event Services located in New York. Nick is also the founder of the Block and Roll Systems, Inc., the industry standard for tent ballasting. In this class, attendees will learn more about tent ballasting and the various methods available that will provide increased tent safety. Attendees will also learn more about the ballasting tool available to code enforcement officials, fire marshals, inspectors.
